### Rally for Darfur (East Africa)

Over 2,751 villages in the Darfur region have been destroyed or damaged, with more than 400,000 killed and 2.3 million displaced from their homes since the genocide began in 2003. On Sun., May 18, activities will begin at Freedom Corner, the intersection of Centre Ave. and Pride St. across from Mellon arena and conclude in Market Square, downtown Pgh. Participants will carry printed signs that name these villages in order to bring a human element to these affected by the genocide.
