I hope all of you are enjoying these beautiful days of summer. Summer is a wonderful time to seek opportunities for rest and relaxation. Whether it is vacationing, family gatherings, sitting on the porch, swimming, golfing, amusement parks, concerts, sporting events, or movies, summer is a great time for recreation. Remember what Jesus said to his Apostles, "Come away by yourselves and rest awhile." In light of our need to recharge our batteries, I will be making my annual retreat this coming week (Sun., July 6-Fri., July 11).

I will be making my retreat at the Monfort Mission Retreat Center in Bay Shore, NY (on Long Island). The Missionaries of the Company of Mary, also known as the Monfort Missionaries, is a religious order founded by St. Louis de Monfort. St. Louis was born in France in 1673. He is best known for his love of Our Lady. St. Louis is referred to as the "Apostle of Mary." He wrote *True Devotion to Mary*, in which he expounds on the principle, "to Jesus through Mary." I hope to learn more about Monfortian spirituality during my retreat. Pray for me as I pray for you.
