In light of the Year of St. Paul, Bishop Zubik has called upon each parish to have two extended periods of Eucharistic Adoration to both deepen our love for the Eucharist and to pray for an increase in happier and holier Vocations. Capital "V" Vocation encompasses holy orders, religious life, married life, and single life. We are to also pray for small "v" vocation, which includes everyone's call to be a better disciple of our Lord. Good Samaritan is having its first date for Adoration on Mon., Aug. 4 (see bulletin for details). We need people to sign up for 30 minute time slots to pray before the Eucharist. A sign up sheet is in the main entrance of the church.

In light of our special call to pray before the exposed Eucharist, I remind you that we have Adoration at Good Samaritan every Friday from 3 p.m.-8 p.m., Mass follows at 8 p.m. In addition, St. John's has Adoration every first Wednesday from 8:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m. Come out and pray, it will change your life.
